Quality of Selection

A welcome variety with the number of machines they had, though they lacked any pinball machines. There were classics with plenty of Pac-Man themed and more generic multicades, a DK/DK Jr/Mario Bros machine, a 3 game SEGA Star Wars cabinet, Frogger, and Centipede. Multiple 2+ player machines with Bad Dudes, Simpsons, and TMNT Beat-Em-Ups; side-by-side sit-down racing cabinets with Out Run 2; light gun games, one of which was two player, and three (3) fighting games with Street Fighter 2, Marvel vs Capcom 2, and Capcom vs SNK 2. Newer games with two gimmicky 4 player Pac-Man machines that a young man at a gas station told me he had a lot of fun on with his friends, and a Mario Kart DX Arcade GP machine.

Quality of Hardware

Other than the two, unfortunately, OoS Time Crisis 3 machines everything worked perfectly. I didn't have a problem with a single machine. I will chalk my embarrassing inability to get Geese to do a Raging Storm up to a simple skill issue. I can really do it I swear!

Atmosphere

It was lovely, simply darling. Nothing but screens and sounds of working machines. The walls had some arcade themed posters, curtains, wall ornaments, and themed painting on the wall.

Food/Drink

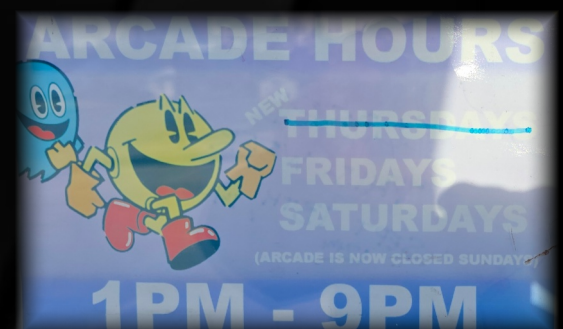

The two light gun games, Point Blank 2 and Silent Scope X, were particularly generous with the amount of time you could get out of them, and I had to walk away from both of them and let the game figure out that I was done because I had a time constraint and more games to check out for the review!
